


Attitude Intermediate Programme: Friendship Factor

Frost or Snow Days

We will send a text message to you as soon as the call to cancel or make a late start due to weather is confirmed. Local radio continue to broadcast cancellations and any calls that are for all primary and intermediate schools relate to us.
