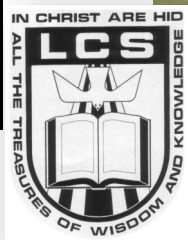


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Dear Parents

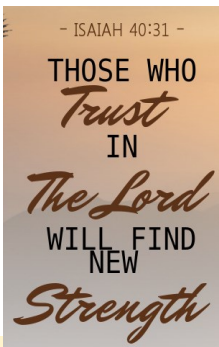

LCS Soccer Team—The team enjoyed their first game with NEVN School and are scheduled to play their next game with Pine Hill School.



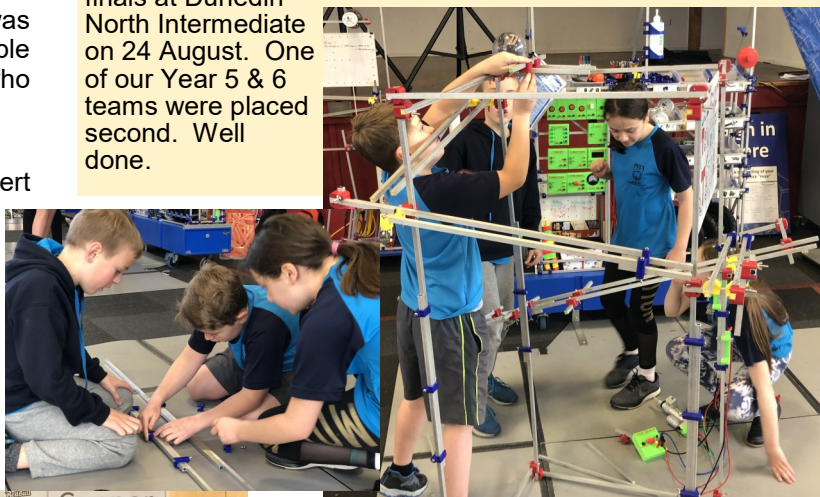
