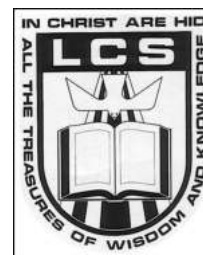


# LIBERTON CHRISTIAN SCHOOL NEWSLETTER
