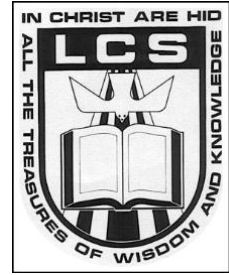


LIBERTON CHRISTIAN SCHOOL NEWSLETTER
