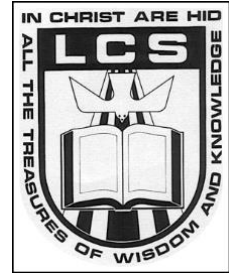


# LIBERTON CHRISTIAN SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

**LIBERTON CHRISTIAN SCHOOL ENROLMENTS 2027**

If you have a pre-schooler that you intend to enrol at Liberton during 2027 please pop into the office to get an enrolment form to complete at your earliest convenience.

Applications are due by **1 August 2026 for commencement at any time during 2027**. All applications will be considered at the Board of Trustees meeting following the closing date. Siblings have the first priority for enrolment. If the number of applications exceeds the number of places available, our Enrolment Scheme will be applied to determine the order of places offered.

**FROST OR SNOW DAYS**



It’s the time of year when heavy frost or snow may occasionally make travel to school difficult. We will send an email and/or app message to you as soon as the call to cancel or make a late start due to weather is confirmed. Local radio stations continue to broadcast cancellations and any calls that are for all primary and intermediate schools relate to us. The most important point is not to attempt travel if you feel unsafe on the road due to frost or snow.
